*Hebrews 6:1a Therefore **let us move beyond the elementary teachings about Christ and be taken forward to maturity...** NIV*

2. God speaks about _____ to His people.

*Hebrews 3:12-17 See to it, brothers and sisters, that **none of you has a sinful, unbelieving heart that turns away from the living God.** ¹³ But encourage one another daily, as long as it is called "Today," **so that none of you may be hardened by sin's deceitfulness.** ¹⁴ We have come to share in Christ, **if indeed we hold our original conviction firmly to the very end.** ¹⁵ As has just been said: "Today, if you hear his voice, do not harden your hearts as you did in the rebellion." ¹⁶ Who were they who heard and rebelled? **Were they not all those Moses led out of Egypt?** ¹⁷ And with whom was he angry for forty years? **Was it not with those who sinned, whose bodies perished in the wilderness?** NIV*

3. God speaks about a _____ to His people.

*Hebrews 9:15 For this reason **Christ is the mediator of a new covenant**, that those who are called may receive the promised eternal inheritance—**now that he has died as a ransom to set them free from the sins committed under the first covenant.** NIV*

*Hebrews 8:5-6 **They serve at a sanctuary that is a copy and shadow of what is in heaven.** This is why Moses was warned when he was about to build the tabernacle: "See to it that you make everything according to the pattern shown you on the mountain." ⁶ But in fact **the ministry Jesus has received is as superior to theirs as the covenant of which he is mediator is superior to the old one, since the new covenant is established on better promises.** NIV*

*Hebrews 8:6 But now He has obtained **a more excellent ministry**, to the extent that **He is also the mediator of a better covenant**, which has been enacted on **better promises.** NASB*

Matthew 8:5-8, 10 *When Jesus had entered Capernaum, a centurion came to him, asking for help. ⁶ "Lord," he said, "my servant lies at home paralyzed, suffering terribly." ⁷ **Jesus said to him, "Shall I come and heal him?"** ⁸ The centurion replied, "**Lord, I do not deserve to have you come under my roof. But just say the word, and my servant will be healed.**" ¹⁰ When Jesus heard this, he was amazed and said to those following him, "Truly I tell you, **I have not found anyone in Israel with such great faith.**" NIV*

John 1:1-3 *In the beginning was the Word, and the Word was with God, and **the Word was God**. ² He was with God in the beginning. ³ **Through him all things were made; without him nothing was made that has been made**... NIV*

Hebrews 1:3a *The Son is the radiance of God's glory and the exact representation of his being, **sustaining all things by his powerful word**. NIV*

Luke 8:22-25 *One day Jesus said to his disciples, "Let us go over to the other side of the lake." So they got into a boat and set out. ²³ As they sailed, he fell asleep. A squall came down on the lake, so that the boat was being swamped, and they were in great danger. ²⁴ The disciples went and woke him, saying, "Master, Master, we're going to drown!" **He got up and rebuked the wind and the raging waters; the storm subsided, and all was calm.** ²⁵ "Where is your faith?" he asked his disciples. In fear and amazement they asked one another, "**Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him.**" NIV*
