John 13:34-35 "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. ³⁵ By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another." NIV

John 15:12-14 My command is this: Love each other as I have loved you. ¹³ Greater love has no one than this: to lay down one's life for one's friends. ¹⁴ You are my friends if you do what I command. NIV

Matthew 22:34-40 Hearing that Jesus had silenced the Sadducees, the Pharisees got together. ³⁵ One of them, an expert in the law, tested him with this question: ³⁶ "Teacher, which is the greatest commandment in the Law?" ³⁷ Jesus replied: "Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.' ³⁸ This is the first and greatest commandment. ³⁹ And the second is like it: 'Love your neighbor as yourself.' ⁴⁰ All the Law and the Prophets hang on these two commandments." NIV

Matthew 5:17 "Do not think that I have come to abolish the Law or the Prophets; I have not come to abolish them but to fulfill them. NIV

Romans 13:10 Love does no harm to a neighbor. Therefore love is the fulfillment of the law. NIV

Hebrews 13:3 **Continue to remember those in prison** as if you were together with them in prison, and **those who are mistreated as if you yourselves were suffering.** NIV

Hebrews 13:3 **Remember the Lord's people who are in jail** and be concerned for them. Don't forget those who are suffering, **but imagine you are there with them.** CEV

Hebrews 13:4 **Marriage should be honored by all, and the marriage bed kept pure,** for God will judge the adulterer and **all the sexually immoral.** NIV

Hebrews 13:5-6 **Keep your lives free from the love of money and be content with what you have,** because God has said, **"Never will I leave you; never will I forsake you."** ⁶ So we say with confidence, **"The Lord is my helper; I will not be afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?"** NIV

1 Timothy 6:10 **For the love of money is a root of all kinds of evil.** Some people, eager for money, **have wandered from the faith** and pierced themselves with many griefs. NIV

Hebrews 13:7-8, 17 Remember your leaders, who spoke the word of God to you. Consider the outcome of their way of life and imitate their faith. ⁸ **Jesus Christ is the same** yesterday and today and forever. ¹⁷ **Have confidence in your leaders and submit to their authority, because they keep watch over you** as those who must give an account. Do this **so that their work will be a joy, not a burden,** for that would be of no benefit to you. NIV

7. By loving and _____ the _____ you _____ about Jesus Christ.

Hebrews 13:9-10 **Do not be carried away by all kinds of strange teachings.** It is good for our hearts **to be strengthened by grace, not by eating ceremonial foods,** which is of no benefit to those who do so. ¹⁰ **We have an altar from which those who minister at the tabernacle have no right to eat.** NIV

8. By loving to _____ and _____ resources.

Hebrews 13:15-16, 18-19, 24-25 Through Jesus, therefore, **let us continually offer to God a sacrifice of praise—the fruit of lips that openly profess his name.** ¹⁶ And **do not forget to do good and to share with others,** for with such sacrifices God is pleased. ¹⁸ Pray for us. We are sure that we have a clear conscience and desire to live honorably in every way. ¹⁹ I particularly urge you to pray so that I may be restored to you soon. ²⁴ **Greet all your leaders and all the Lord's people.** Those from Italy send you their greetings. ²⁵ Grace be with you all.
